ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2019-20

- The proposal for seminar on "Quality Improvement in Higher Education Through Skill Based Programmes for New India" was accepted by NAAC with financial assistance.
- The committee decided to organize the seminar on 31st August, 2019. Other important matters regarding the National Seminar were also discussed.
- The events to be organized in the academic year 2019-20 were briefed by the coordinator.
 The Principal requested all the members to execute events with proper coordination with the concerned faculty.
- The committee also discussed how to lay down quality improvement strategies in the areas of teaching-learning, research, examination system, evaluation and ICT for the year 2019-20.
- It was decided that to smoothen the entry of new students into the institution, orientation
 programmes both at the central level and the level of faculties and departments should be
 fully implemented.
- It was instructed that each Department have to maintain mentoring/counseling process to solve students' problems and to enable them to meet their educational responsibilities.
- The Result analysis is conducted by the various departments and the outcome of the same is utilized for improving teaching learning quality and student performance.
- The Revised format of AQAR is discussed with all members of IQAC. New format of AQAR (doc format) will be sent to Criteria-wise convener. They can consolidate the questions, send it to HOD of the departments, summarize the report and send the final report to IQAC and also discussed to submit the AQAR before the dead line.
- Academic Research Coordinator discussed the need and the nature of proposals of Minor Research Projects to be submitted to UGC and other Government bodies. Also faculties were encouraged to prepare the proposals for seminars the research projects under



IMPRESS and ICSSR. This was followed by a discussion to decide on the departments to prepare proposals. Guidelines for research projects were also given.

- The format of the criteria-wise report was mailed to the convener. Documentary Evidences of the last year NAAC data was submitted to the IQAC coordinator.
- The IQAC coordinator elaborated academic results which are improved compared to previous year.
- The IQAC committee suggested the following Action Plan for result improvement:
 - 1. The subjects are categorized on the bases of last three years in hard and soft categories.
 - 2. The focus will be on the improvement of the attendance of the students.
 - 3. Weak students should be identified on the basis of their internal exam results and counsel them for the difficulties encountered in exam.
 - 4. Encourage students to improve their grades so the quality results may improve.

- The proposal for National Seminar on Trilingual Formula and 150 years of Gandhi has been sanctioned by Sahitya Akadmi with the aid of financial assistance.
